### Page 19

Did the Hebrew midwives lie? **Yes**

Was this a sin? **No**

What does Exodus 20:16 say you shall not do? **Bear False Witness**

Why did the Lord threaten to kill Moses?

What hadn't he done? (see Genesis 17:9-14) **Circumcised His Son**

### Page 20

What source of spiritual power is there besides God? **Satan/The Devil**

Who wins when these two powers fight? (see Exodus 7:12) **God**

The Nile was identified with the Egyptian **god** called **Hapi**.

The Egyptian goddess **Heket** was often worshipped in the form of a **frog**.

The plague of **darkness** was directed at the Egyptian sun god **Ra**.

The Egyptians had a bull god named **Apis**, a cow goddess called **Hathor**, and a ram god called **Khnum**.

Which plague is significant in light of these facts? **Dead Livestock**  
This isn't directly related to one of the first nine plagues but the protector of the Pharaoh who was **Wadjet** depicted as a **snake**?

These plagues were directed at the Egyptians **false religious beliefs**. It showed that everything they worshipped as a **god** was less powerful than **God**.
