TO EXPRESS DISAPPOINTMENT TODAY!**

The Naperville Marathon is scheduled to pass along our parish grounds closing our parking lots on Sunday morning, October 23.

There is still time to get this changed, but we need your help.

After several conversations with the Marathon Committee, we have received no viable solution to the problem so we need your help. Although the Marathon Committee had made a commitment to Naperville churches in the past not to allow the marathon to pass near any churches on Sunday morning, the marathon route is scheduled to pass along Benton Street right next to our church on **Sunday, October 23rd** during principal Mass times. Not only will this create a major obstacle to our parishioners getting to Mass, but the Marathon Committee has told us that they will close our Benton Lot and obstruct exit of our main lot onto Benton Street between the hours of **6:30 am and 9:30 am** Sunday, October 23.

There is no reason why the marathon must pass by our parish.
