**Fall 2016 Field Trips and Service Calendar**

- August 21** – Welcome Weekend: An open house will be held in the Teen Zone after the 9:30 and 11am Masses. Youth will make announcements and serve refreshments after Mass.
- September 2** – Sign-ups for Feed My Starving Children (Sept 16) due online
- September 3** – Bristol Renaissance Faire: Travel back in time 450 years to the town of Bristol, England. Meet at Sts Peter and Paul at 8:30am and return by 8:30pm. We may briefly stop by Illinois Beach if time allows on our return. Cost is \$22.00 made to “SSPP.” Please bring a sack lunch and spending money. Driver/Chaperones are not charged.
- September 16** – Feed My Starving Children: Meet at the food court in Fox Valley Mall for dinner at 6:30pm. After dinner, our shift at FMSC runs from 8-9:30pm. *Transportation is not provided.* Sign up at [www.fmsc.org](http://www.fmsc.org) with our “Join code” – 955381
- September 24** – K of C Rosary Rally: Meet at Planned Parenthood at 9am to pray the rosary. Then bike 10 miles to pray at the IVF Clinic in Downtown Naperville. Bring your own bike. You must fill out a waiver from the K of C and a parent must accompany. Afterwards we’ll grab pizza at La Fiamme!
- September 25** – Harvest Sunday Flyer Pass-out: The Youth Group will be passing out flyers on Sunday evening at 5:30pm for about an hour and a half.
- October 2** – Harvest Sunday: Harvest Sunday will begin at 1:30pm. Two to four adult volunteers are needed to drive the High School group. Concludes at 5:30pm.
- October 7** – Crosstown Classic at North Central College Benedetti-Wehrli Stadium: Naperville Central vs. Naperville North! I’ll meet you at 6:45pm.
- October 8** – Fright Fest at Six Flags: We’ll attend 8am Mass together and then have breakfast on the go (provided) as we drive to Six Flags. \$40 includes admission, transportation, and breakfast. All must bring a sack lunch and spending money for food (\$15-20 recommended). *Chaperone drivers are needed and do not pay for admission or parking.* Return by 10pm
- October 15** – Our Lady of the Angels Mission Meet at Sts Peter and Paul at 8am. We’ll travel to OLA mission and work with the Franciscan sisters from 9am-12pm. We’ll stop for lunch on the way back and be home by 2pm! Permission slips due October 7<sup>th</sup>.

**October 22** – Hallowed Houses!! (Chicago Church Tour): Visit four of Chicago's most beautiful churches. We'll pray Terce with the monks at Holy Cross Monastery, see St Adalbert's modeled after St Paul "Outside the Walls," and more (but I don't want to give it all away)! Meet at SSPP at 8am and return around 3pm. Cost is \$25 *per person*. This is an event for members of the Youth Group *and their families!* Please bring a sack lunch.

**November 11** – Bowling: We'll try out Brunswick's new facilities the night before they have grand reopening. Meet at 6pm on 1515 Aurora Ave at for a night of bowling, pizza, and *new laser tag course*. Cost is \$15.

**November 12-13** – Fundraiser Weekend: Many volunteers are needed to cover all of the Masses this weekend. Funds will benefit the March for Life and Youth Group trips. Ten percent of the money will go towards sponsoring a family in need this Christmas. Participants in the March for Life must participate in at least two Masses this weekend. More details to come.

**November 19** – Rosary for Life: Meet at 9pm at Planned Parenthood with the Knights of Columbus.

**December 10** – Our Lady of the Angels Christmas Party: The Sisters need help putting on their annual community Christmas party. We leave at 7:30am and return by 4pm. Respond by December 3 if you would like to help.

**December 23** – A Christmas Carol: We will leave at 12pm to go see *A Christmas Carol* at Drury Lane Theatre. Cost is \$15 for youth and free for chaperones. I only have 21 tickets, so please sign up early to make sure you can come!

**January 15** – March for Life Chicago: We will ride a bus from Sts Peter and Paul to downtown Chicago to march in front of the City Hall in defense of life. Dinner is afterwards in downtown. Sign-up by Dec 31. Meet at SSPP at 12:45pm. Cost TBD.

**January 25-29** – March for Life DC: The March for Life will take place Wednesday night through Sunday, so plan on missing 2 days of school. Trip includes Vigil Mass at the National Shrine, the March itself, Celebratory Dinner, Arlington Cemetery, and much more! You must pay \$100 deposit, but the total cost to send one youth is \$341. The final cost will be determined by the November 12-13<sup>th</sup> fundraiser and by how many youth will go. *Participation in the fundraiser is a requirement for attending.*
